Monday, 10-12-09	integrity /ɪn'tɛɡrɪti/ (noun)	the quality of being honest and having high moral principles	<i>You can trust him because he is a man of integrity.</i>
Tuesday, 10-13-09	perseverance /ˌpɜrsə'veɪrəns/ (noun)	determination to keep trying to do something difficult	<i>He failed many times, but he showed great perseverance and kept trying until he succeeded.</i>
Wednesday, 10-14-09	respect /rɪ'spɛkt/ (noun)	showing consideration, understanding and regard for people, places, and things	<i>You should show more respect to your grandfather.</i>
Thursday, 10-15-09	citizenship /'sɪtəzənʃɪp/ (noun)	knowing, understanding, and displaying a high regard for rules, laws, government , and heritage	<i>A strong democracy needs people who believe in the values of citizenship.</i>
Friday, 10-16-09	erroneous /ə'rouniəs/ (noun)	mistaken; wrong	<i>I thought my answer was correct, but it was erroneous</i>
